We are pleased that you have decided to participate in the Skate park Programs. It is required by the Village of Catskill that this Hold Harmless Release be completed by each participant. The mandatory understanding concerning participation is listed in three parts as follows:

Part One:

You agree, on behalf of yourself, your assigns, executors, and heirs, to release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Village of Catskill, and its officials, officers, agents and employees from any and all liability, damage, claim of any nature arising out of or in any way related to your participation at this skate park except those things caused by the sole negligence of the Village of Catskill.

You state that you are aware of all the inherent dangers and risk involved in Skate Park Participation including but not limited to: bodily injury, sprains, fractures, dislocations, lacerations, concussions, skin disease, eye, head, neck or back injuries, or death. Some specific risks include, but are not limited to:

1. Being hit or struck by sports equipment (skateboards, skates, bikes).
2. Being hit, struck, physically challenged or collision with other skate park participants.
3. Collision with skate park facilities (floor, structure, ground, rink, obstacles, boards, mat).
3. You understand that the terms of this agreement are legally binding and certify that you are signing this agreement of your own free will after carefully reading it.

Part Two: Medical Authorization

In the event of serious illness or injury, I authorize the local ambulance service to transport me (as deemed necessary) to a hospital emergency facility for treatment. All reasonable attempts to reach the emergency contact listed on this form will be made. I accept responsibility for all costs involved in my transport and treatment. My hospital insurance carrier is listed above.

Part Three: Facility Rules and Regulations

1. The Village of Catskill Skateboard Park is strictly for residents of the Catskill Central School District with proper ID. Non-residents with valid ID card only. No exceptions.
2. All skaters must be appropriately registered with the Village of Catskill.
3. For skaters under the age of 18 years, a parent or legal guardian must be present at the time of registration. The parent or legal guardian must show picture ID, birth certificate and proof of residence.
4. Only children 7 years of age and older are permitted, and children between the ages of 7 and 11 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times while the child utilizes the skate park.
5. A valid Village of Catskill ID card is required for entrance to skateboard park.
6. Skaters ages 7-11 must wear appropriate safety equipment: ANSI or SNELL-approved helmet, kneepads, and elbow pads. Inline skaters must also wear wrist guards. All equipment is to be used per manufacturer's specifications. **All Skaters must wear at minimum a helmet.** All skaters must wear shirts and shoes.
7. The park will not be used when the equipment, apparatus, and/or pavement is wet or icy.
8. Spectators are not permitted entry into skate area unless registered and wearing proper safety equipment.
9. Skaters are to use only the equipment that is appropriate for their skill level.
10. Recklessness will not be tolerated. All skaters must use this facility responsibly to avoid injury to themselves or others. The use of proper skater etiquette is expected at all times.
11. No skating or trespassing is permitted when the skate park is closed. Violators will be prosecuted.
12. Profanity, abusive language and fighting will not be tolerated.
13. The following are not allowed in skate park: food, beverages, gum, smoking/drugs and loose items such as backpacks, coats, and radios/boom boxes. Glass containers are prohibited.
14. Any infraction of rules may result in loss of skate park privileges.
15. The village has the right to determine the amount of skaters at any session.
